




IN MEMORY

JEANETTE PARKER

JANUARY 20, 1973-JANUARY 18, 2024



Long time librarian, Jeanette Ann Parker passed away in her home on January 18, 2024. Jeanette was very active in WALA and KLA. After she completed her degree at Barclay they hired her as the librarian for the college. She started in 1999 and continued until 2006 when she made the decision to move back to Wichita. She was hired as the Serials Librarian in 2006 at Friends University. In 2014 she decided to make a change and began at Newman University as the assistant librarian. She was then promoted to the Reference and Instructional Librarian in 2017. In this position she was able to show her gifts with teaching and developing curriculum for students. At Newman she worked with Steve whom she greatly enjoyed working with. They worked very well together and she considered him a friend. In 2022 she became the Director of Library Services at Kansas Health Science Center. Here she was able to develop their program for the use of library information for the students. Jeanette was currently a Ph.D. candidate for the degree Doctor of Philosophy, Library and Information Management, at Emporia State University, School of Library and Information Management. Jeanette had successfully completed all required courses and all qualifying examinations. Dr. Mirah Dow, Ph.D., Emporia State University, served as the Chair of Jeanette's dissertation research committee along with Dr. Stan Trembach, Ph.D., Emporia State University, and Dr. Denise Nelson, Ph.D., Ryan Library, Point Loma Nazarene University, San Diego, CA. Jeanette was an excellent librarian and doctoral student. She was a highly valued colleague by her classmates and professors. Jeanette's dissertation topic was information literacy instruction at faith-based academic institutions. Jeanette served as Director of Library Services librarian at the Kansas Health Science Center in downtown Wichita, KS. 

She was never satisfied with being just a member. She always ended up in some kind of leadership capacity. Elections will be held in person at the WALA Spring meeting in May 2024.






